RIDING LESSONS

Individual lesson on school horse (30 minutes)	£400	Yard visits, lectures, talks and conferences are charged accordingly. Squad training with discipline specific Coaches are charged accordingly.
Group riding lesson on school horse (45 minutes)	£420	
Lead rein lesson (30 minutes)	£260	Bespoke programmes for advanced riders are available on request.
Individual private coaching on own horse (30 minutes)	£420

CHANGING LIVES THROUGH HORSES

The British Horse Society Changing Lives Through Horses is an alternative education programme where young people can develop key life skills. This is achieved through practical horse care and handling and recognized with structured awards and certificates. The programme is charged at £440 per term for a weekly one hour session.

AFFILIATION AND COMPETITION FEES

*Saddle Club Membership	£15 /year
NSEA Affiliation Fee	£20/annum

*All students who use the equestrian facilities will be automatically enrolled into the LCRA Saddle Club, this membership fee is used to buy equipment for the academy and support special events, academy competitions and fun days.

LIVERY (PER TERM)

Full Livery £2,664 - The pupil is not responsible for the day-to-day care of their horse but is expected to ride it at least four times a week.

Loanee Horse Exclusive £4,364 - The pupil cares for their loan horse twice a day and is expected to ride at least four times a week. Additional charges are for lessons, competition fees and transport. Holiday livery is not charged.

Part Livery £2,188 - The pupil cares for their horse twice daily and is expected to ride it four times a week.

Working Livery £1,190 - The pupil cares for their horse and can ride it three times a week, as a working livery the school will use the horse for up to five hours a week.

All horses on these livery packages will receive quality bedding, forage, feed, daily turnout and exercise, regular checks (including a late check) and experienced care. Use of the solarium, wash boxes and washing machine is not charged.

Livery is charged termly in advance. If you wish your horse to stay at school during the holidays you will be charged a full livery on a weekly basis.

On arrival all horses (except International) will have these additional charges:

Wormer	£25
Stable start-up bedding	£35
Total	£60

International Horses arriving from overseas will be quarantined for two weeks. Additional charges will be a Veterinary check on arrival, worming and any transport expenses.

You can secure your stable for September by paying a one-off retainer of £50.

A month's notice is required if you wish to cancel or amend your livery arrangement.

A deposit of £400 is taken against fees not paid and is refundable at the end of your livery contract.

EQUESTRIAN ADDITIONAL SERVICES

(Full, Part and Working livery)

Routine dental checks	£95

Wormers or faecal worm counts	£32
Supplements	additional cost if required
Transport	65p/mile and staff hours
Competition fees (including competition stabling)	as required
Saddlery + biting checks (and any necessary tack required)	as required
Exercise (hacked)	£25/hour
Exercise (schooled)	£45/45 mins
Clipping and trimming	£15-75
Tack cleaning	£15/set
Grass holiday/rest turnout	£42/week
Lorry/trailer parking at school	£10/week

All veterinary and shoeing accounts must be settled half-termly. Additional extras will be charged at the end of each term.
